

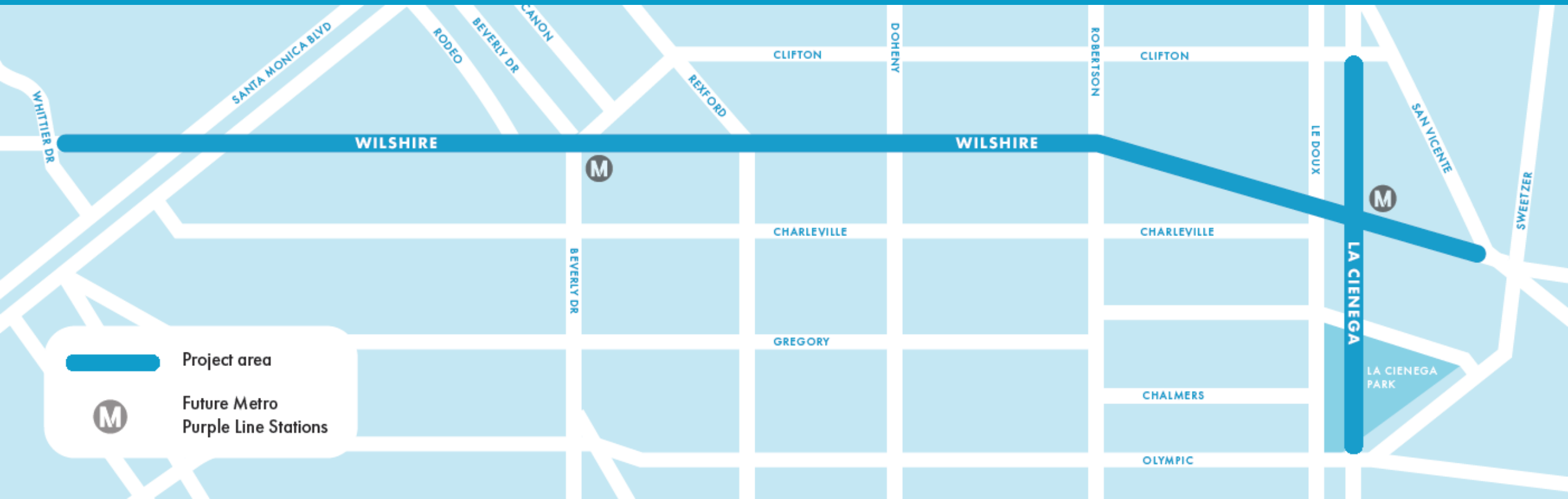

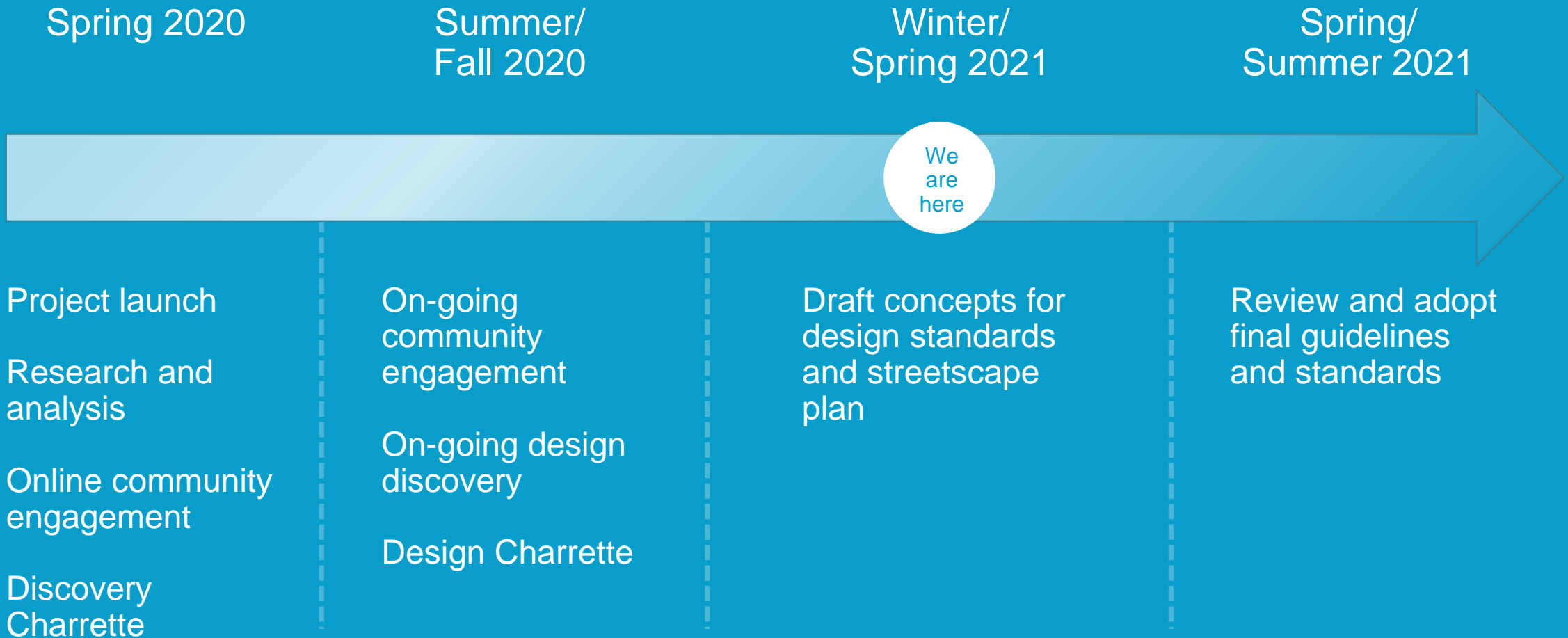

- Southeast neighborhoods

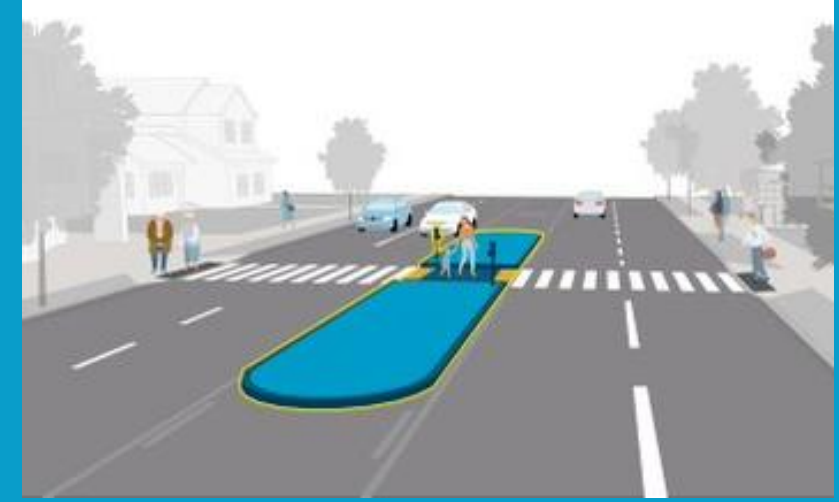

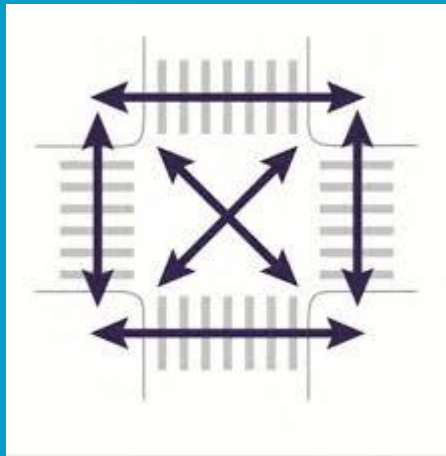

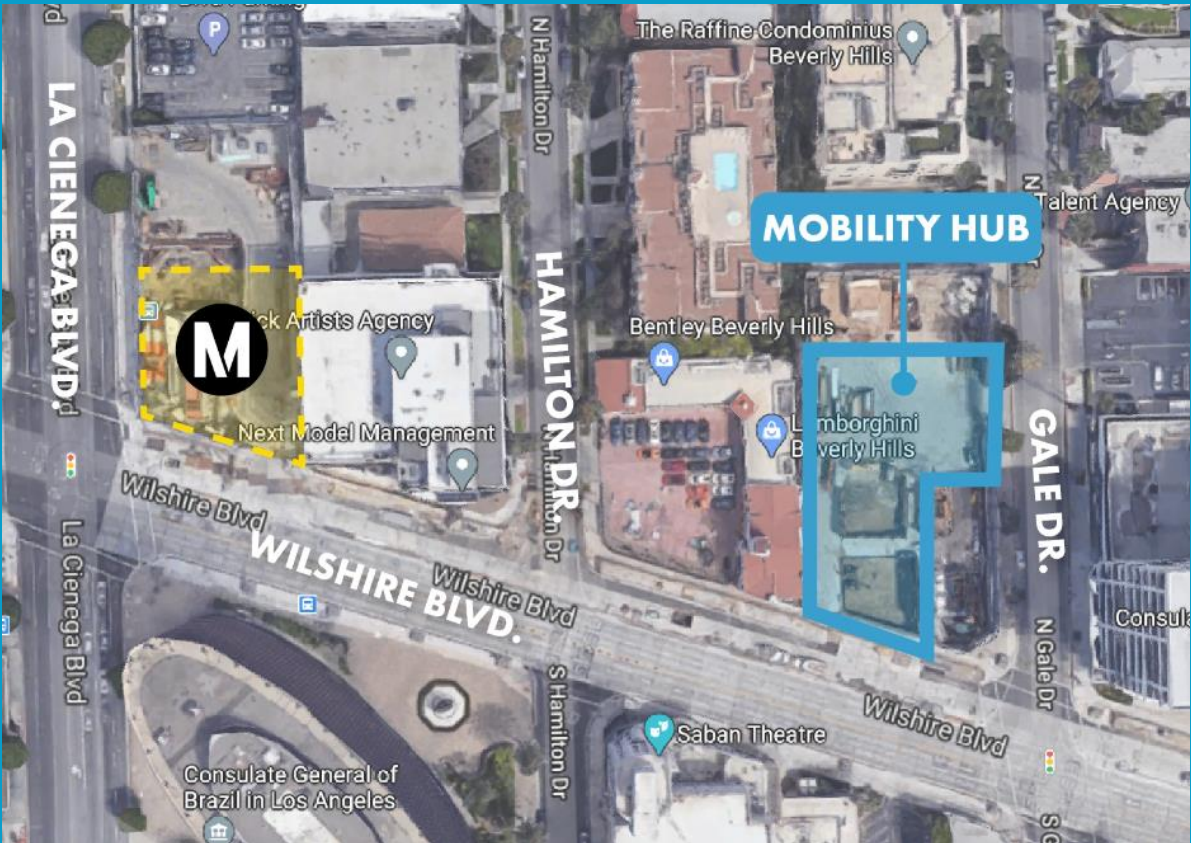
