La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex Public Input Results and Preliminary Enhancement Options Are Being Presented to City Council

Beverly Hills, Calif. – The Beverly Hills City Council will hear a final report from the months-long public input gathering process regarding what to do at La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex. Community Services Director, Nancy Hunt-Coffey and urban design consultants from Johnson Favaro, will present preliminary ideas and options for La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex based on the public feedback gathered.

Let your voice be heard and attend the City Council's regular public meeting on Tuesday, December 18 at 7:00 p.m. at City Hall.

David Ceppos of Sacramento State, Consensus and Collaboration Program (CCP), an independent consultant hired by the City to conduct a thorough public engagement process about La Cienega Park and Recreation Complex, presented a detailed report on his findings to City Council on November 20, 2018. Based on these findings, City Council gave direction to identify opportunities and challenges that will inform alternative approaches to a master plan guiding redevelopment of the park.
